UNI INCUBATOR

Start-up scholars

Universities used to teach students the skills they needed to get a good job, but now they're also helping them develop their own potentially lucrative start-ups.

Past and present computer science students at the University of New South Wales with a bright idea will be offered access to an on-campus business incubator space for up to six months rent-free under a scheme to begin next year.

Vodafone creator Adam Brimo has applied for a place in the Venture Incubator Space after deciding to opt out of a well-paid job, at least for now, to concentrate on his own new meeting and task managing software: Mijura.

"It's hard to turn down a job at a big company, but I think if you just take an extra year or

two to start your own business you learn more," he said.

Brimo said working at home could be very solitary and it was hard work, but the new space would provide some support.

"It's really about having a space around other people who are doing a similar thing and providing a bit of atmosphere to get your business off the ground," he said.

The university has already received several submissions for the space where participants will get a desk, internet access and a telephone.

School for Computer Science and Engineering head Maurice Pagnucco said the scheme was about fostering ideas.

"Students with a bit of an idea don't have a lot of resources. We (hope) to get fairly like-minded students together ... to help each other out," he said.

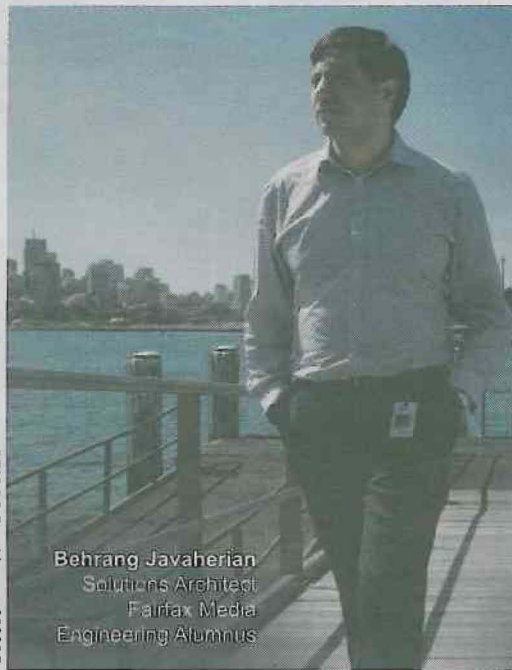
Don't sweat on solution
